We are blessed with an excellent choir, orchestra, bell ensemble and more to enrich the worship experience and glorify God. The Director of Worship Arts will shepherd and administrate the volunteers (around 150) and staff towards excellence in worship arts for our in-person and digital congregations.

Responsibilities

1. Shepherd

- The Worship Staff
 - Through weekly meetings, individual discipleship, prayer, and counsel, and creating a positive and productive team dynamic
- The Worship Volunteers (around 150 people)
 - This includes the choir, orchestra, brass ensembles, Westminster Bell Choir, and other ensembles (Flute Ensemble, Men's Chorus, Women's Chorus, Sacred Dance Team, individual solos, etc.)
 - Shepherding these groups like a small church including counseling, prayer, and discipleship rehearsals

2. Administrate

- The Worship Team
 - Leading Weekly Staff Meetings
 - Give vision and make sure that we are on task with the church's future vision
 - Lead in a creative and adaptable way
 - Oversee the Worship budget and align funds to vision
- The Worship Volunteers
 - Long Range Planning
 - Choosing music for 6 months in advance so all music can be ordered, filed, and distributed
 - Weekly Planning
 - Making sure that all the volunteers have everything needed to serve in an excellent way
 - Oversee the recruitment and development of younger artists (music, dance, etc)
 - o Work with technology team to ensure excellent sound, lighting, and video in worship spaces

- 4. Short Term
 - a. Creating weekly worship themes in conjunction with the Teaching Pastor
 - b. Creating worship services that include fresh ideas using all the arts.
 - c. Investigating new worship ideas
 - i. Conferences, online services, and other study material
- Long Term
 - Creating and producing 4 concerts per year
 - 2 from the church volunteers (Christmas Eve and Spring)
 - 2 from outside artists (Fall and Spring)
 - o Apprised of current musical and worship trends as well as classical standards.
 - Values Reformed liturgies, standards, and seasons of the church year.
 - Arranging and writing new music
 - Knowledgeable of Finale and other music software programs
